
## Activities in Each Location

The projects have been implemented, which consists of many activities: Arbitration, Legal awareness sessions, Awareness visits to civil society organizations, Community dialogue sessions, Legal consultations, Focused discussion sessions, Legal representation of female cases in addition to a research activity on the problem of non-registration of civil incidents.

The Locations according to each donor as:
Kaftin, Kelly and Maaret Tamsrin For *GIZ*Azaz, Afrin and Darat Izza for *CLFI*and Mare' and Qabbassin For *EuroMed*.

The total number of participants reached 2155 beneficiaries, and the percentage of women was about 63,9 % of the total beneficiaries.









#### Beneficiaries by Activities

#### Gender of Beneficiaries




# Categories of Beneficiaries

The beneficiaries were selected from all segments of society without any discrimination.

The percentage of women among the beneficiaries was approximately 63.9 %, while the percentage of the displaced was approximately 47.7 % of the total beneficiaries.


In terms of the scientific level, women who obtained a university degree were approximately 28.91 % of the total beneficiaries and 27.31 % of the total women participating in the project activities.




Beneficiaries by social status




Beneficiaries By Education





The number of members of the arbitraion boards formed in the project locations was increased from three to five people. A three-day training was conducted for the new and old members in the city of Kelly, to be on a convergent level of knowledge in the peaceful ways of resolving disputes.




The number of beneficiaries was 15 persons, one of whom was a woman. The percentage of those holding a university degree was 66.67% of the total beneficiaries, and the percentage of displaced persons was 13.3% of the total members of the arbitration boards.

# Resolving Legal Disputes

The selected arbitration boards intervene and resolve conflicts and legal problems through the arbitration method to encourage the beneficiaries not to review informal bodies in light of the irregularity of judicial work at work locations.

78 conflicts were resolved in the project sites, the number of beneficiaries of this activity reached 168, the displaced constituted 36.9% of the total beneficiaries, which indicates the higher rate of conflicts among the residents of the local community under the current circumstances.

Financial disputes (commercial partnerships, inheritance distribution...) constituted the largest percentage of the disputes that were resolved, 47.4 % of the total disputes.


Type of Resolved Disputes







91 visits were made to civil society organizations operating in each of Kelly , Maaret Tamsrin, Mare' and Qabbassin . The percentage of women beneficiaries was 54.17 % of the total beneficiaries, and the percentage of those with a university degree among the beneficiaries was 67.19 %.


It was noted that there is a high percentage of IDPs among the employees of these organizations, as their percentage was

approximately 34.9 % of the total beneficiaries.









#### Beneficiaries by Educational level






12 community dialogue sessions were implemented, 4 in each of the project sites, in which 114 beneficiaries participated. Women constituted 73.68 % of the total beneficiaries, and the percentage of displaced persons was 42.11 % of the total beneficiaries to discuss the most important problems faced by the participants and the solutions they use to alleviate the problems. The effects of these problems and an attempt by the association's team to propose alternative solutions that do not pose any danger to the beneficiaries.






Beneficiaries by Location




144 legal awareness sessions for local communities were carried out for 792 people in 63 groups, The topics of the legal awareness sessions from the Syrian laws issued before the fifties are on the following topics: (Arbitration - Personal Status - Rights of IDPs - Proof of Personal Documents).

Women constituted 73.74 % of the total participants, and the displaced 40.4 % of the total beneficiaries, and those with a university degree was 33.46 % of the total beneficiaries.


#### Beneficiaries by Location




#### Beneficiaries by Educational level




#### Beneficiaries by Social status




#### Beneficiaries by Gender





The association's team received 716 legal consultations through official identifiers, the highest percentage of personal status consultations was 53.78 % of the total consultations, and the percentage of women was 70.24 % of the total beneficiaries, and the percentage of displaced beneficiaries was the highest with 60.81 % of the total beneficiaries.

# SCDD Team Training



During this period, individual interview questions related to the problem of non-recording of civil incidents were also written and a guide was created for dialogue sessions






Beneficiaries by Age




Beneficiaries by Educational level

## Bilateral interviews




120 individual interviews were carried out, distributed among the displaced and residing in the project sites and who had a problem of not registering civil incidents. The highest percentage of the number of individual interviews in Maaret Tamsrin was 58.3% as a result of the high number of residents and displaced people in it, women constituted 43.3% of the total beneficiaries. The displaced constituted 52.5% of the total beneficiaries.









#### Beneficiaries by Age




Beneficiaries by Social status








## Focus Group Discussion










# Training Female Lawyers

The process of development and empowerment of women lawyers was trained and supervised by a specialized legal expert in the city of Azaz.

The training axes focused on the types of courts and their specializations, the prosecution before the civil judiciary, and the conditions for filing a civil case the prosecution before the judiciary. After that, the legal expert spoke about the Syrian Personal Status Law with a focus on laws that preserve women's rights.


The team of female lawyers was also trained to defend and delegate women's rights in civil status cases.


## Legal Representation



After the end of the training, the female lawyers began communicating with women who live in difficult financial and social conditions, especially those residing in the camps who are unable to access justice institutions in order to reduce their suffering and improve the opportunities and options available to them,

as judicial representation was made before the official courts in the project locations for 50 women , 50 cases have been resolved .




# Legal advices
